

## **MEMORANDUM OF COOPERATION IN THE FIELDS OF SCIENCE AND EDUCATION**

**Kangwon National University (Republic of Korea)  
and Namangan State University (Republic of Uzbekistan)**

Kangwon National University (Republic of Korea), represented by its President Heon Young Kim and Namangan State University (Republic of Uzbekistan), represented by its Rector Turgunov Sobitkhon Toshpolatovich, hereinafter jointly referred to as «Parties», considering the mutual striving for cooperation of Republic of Korea and Uzbekistan in development of friendly and trusting relations with common objectives in the field of education and scientific research, have agreed on the following main principles of cooperation:

### **Article 1**

The purpose of this Memorandum is to establish the cooperation in the fields of science and education between the Kangwon National University (Republic of Korea) and Namangan State University (Republic of Uzbekistan) in areas of mutual interest.

### **Article 2**

To implement the purposes of this Memorandum, the Parties agree:

2.1 to invite the scientists for reading lectures, conducting online courses, seminars, webinars, and provide the consultations;

2.2 to promote the establishment of scientific and pedagogical cooperation in mutual interest areas;

2.3 to provide mutual assistance in enhancing the scientific and pedagogical qualifications of scientists and teachers;

2.4 to promote the exchange of students and teachers within the framework of international academic mobility;

2.5 to promote the practical training and internship of students;

2.6. to exchange the experience in the development of the advanced teaching methods;

2.7. to foster the exchange of scientific and educational publications in the field of training highly qualified personnel and ongoing research;

2.8. to assist in the implementation of joint scientific publications in scientific and methodological journals and newsletters, collections of scientific and methodological materials, as well as in world rating journals;

2.9. to provide an opportunity for scientists and faculty of the Parties to act as scientific supervisors, co-supervisors, consultants, reviewers of scientific papers, graduate projects of graduate and undergraduate students;

2.10. to provide an opportunity for scientists and teachers to participate in joint symposia, seminars and conferences;

2.11. to conduct online seminars (subject to availability of opportunities and mutual interest);

2.12. to promote the joint scientific scholarship projects and educational programs;

2.13. to teach PhD program;

2.14. to promote the implementation of double-degree education programs;

### **Article 3**

The Parties agree that the most optimal form of the cooperation is the establishment of direct contacts between two interested parties in specific areas, based on the interest of a particular faculty (institution) or a specific employee in the most problematic form for both sides.

### **Article 4**

The financial terms of the Parties in the implementation of joint projects, as well as other obligations in accordance with this Memorandum, will be determined by additional agreements, which are an integral part of this Memorandum.

### **Article 5**

All scientists and teachers have the opportunity to take part in the exchange, which is carried out on the basis of individual invitations sent by the parties to each other.

### **Article 6**

The Parties have the right to introduce amendments and additions to this Memorandum, which come into force after the approval by both Parties, in accordance with the relevant protocols and memorandums.

### **Article 7**

In the implementation of joint projects, as well as other obligations under this Memorandum, the financial relationships of the Parties will be determined by additional agreements that are an integral part of this Memorandum.

## Article 8

This Memorandum comes into force from the date of its signing and is valid for 5 (five) years if one of the parties has not expressed a wish to terminate this Memorandum and has informed the other party about it in writing. At the same time, the students, who start training within the framework of this Memorandum before the date of termination, shall complete their studies on the conditions established by the Memorandum, regardless of the date of termination of the Memorandum. The validity of the Memorandum may be extended by the agreement of the Parties. This memorandum remains valid when the leadership of the Parties changes.

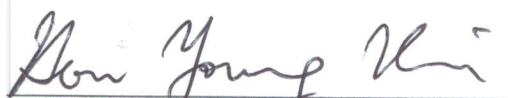
## Article 9

Any notification which one party sends to another, in accordance with the Memorandum, sent by letter or Fax with further submission of original documents in time no later than 2 (two) months from the date of signing of the Memorandum. All copies of the registered and signed Memorandum sent by the Parties by the means of communication (fax, e-mail, etc.) are accepted as the original before the original received. The originals of documents have to be received by the receiving Party within a period not later than two (2) months from the date of signing the Memorandum.

## Article 10

This Memorandum has been made and signed in two copies in English language, having equal legal force.
