

**LETTER OF INTENT
BETWEEN
NAMANGAN STATE UNIVERSITY, UZBEKISTAN
AND
SULTAN IDRIS EDUCATION UNIVERSITY, MALAYSIA**

The purpose of this Letter of Intent (LOI) is to allow for the exchange of undergraduate and graduate students between **Namangan State University**, Namangan, Uzbekistan (hereafter referred to as “NamSU”) and **Sultan Idris Education University**, Perak, Malaysia (hereafter referred to as “UPSI”), that will result in providing for new cultural and intellectual explorations and a broadening of academic, professional, and cultural perspectives of the students of both institutions.

1. Selection of Exchange Students

Exchange candidates will be selected on the basis of academic excellence and other criteria imposed by the Home Institution’s selection committee and will be recommended to the Host Institution. They must meet the admission requirements of the program which they plan to pursue at the Host Institution. The Host Institution retains the right to approve or reject any recommendation based on whether the candidate’s qualifications meet admission requirements at the Host Institution.

2. Number of Exchange Students

Each institution will accept up to 15 Exchange Student each year. Both institutions will review the program annually to ensure a balance in the number of exchanged students. Should an imbalance in the exchange occur, both institutions will endeavor to make adjustments in the following year. Standard lengths of stay for Exchange Students will be one semester or a full academic year. An extension of stay for an Exchange Student at the Host Institution must be officially approved by the Home Institution as well as the Host Institution.

3. Tuition and Other Fees

Exchange Students will not be charged tuition, application and admission fees at the Host Institution. Neither NamSU nor UPSI will be responsible for the costs of board, travel, or other personal expenses.

The Host Institution will provide free accommodation for Exchange Students in a student dormitory for the duration of their stay at the host campus. If the Exchange Student expresses in writing a desire to find alternative accommodation, the Host Institution will assist the exchange student in finding a suitable option. In this case, the exchange student will pay for his/her accommodation himself/herself.

4. Exchange Students’ Obligations

Exchange Students are required to observe the rules and regulations set forth by the Host Institution as well as the immigration regulations and laws of the host country governing the resident status they possess.

The Host Institution shall have the right to return an Exchange Student to the Home Institution if he/she violates the Host Institution’s policies and rules. However, this right will not be exercised without prior consultation with the appropriate official of the Home Institution.

The obligations of the two institutions under this LOI are limited to exchange students only and do not extend to spouses and dependents.

5. Liaison Offices

The Department of International Cooperation at NamSU and the Office of International Affairs at UPSI will be responsible for coordinating the exchange and will handle the details of implementation.

6. Revision and/or Termination

This LOI is subject to review at the end of the first year and shall be effective for five years from the date of final signature. It shall be subject to revision, modification or renewal by a mutual written LOI. Either party may terminate the LOI by written notice submitted at least 90 days in advance of the next academic semester. Termination would not affect students already engaged in the LOI. If the LOI is not renewed by mutual consent, the LOI will conclude at the end of the specified time period, or after activities in progress have concluded.

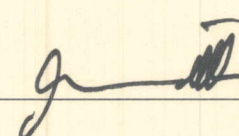
