

Memorandum of Understanding

between

1. The University of Gdansk, seated at 8 Bazynskiego Str., 80-309 Gdansk, Poland, and Namangan State University seated at 161 Boburshox Str. Namangan, Uzbekistan, jointly expressing the intent to develop and promote cooperation in the fields of education and academic research, agree to the following:
 - 1.1 to encourage exchanges and visits in the following categories: undergraduate and graduate students, non-teaching and post-graduate fellows, and faculty members;
 - 1.2 to exchange information and materials in those fields which are of interest to both universities;
 - 1.3 to facilitate communications, networking and arrangements made by faculty, administration or student organization leaders in the accomplishment of the above exchanges;
 - 1.4 to organize joint training, summer programs, language courses, conferences and academic programs;
 - 1.5 to facilitate joint research activities and publications;
 - 1.6 to explore opportunities for double diploma programs in English;
 - 1.7 to support each other in the field of international promotion and student recruitment.
2. The details for the implementation of these activities will be developed mutually for specific projects executed individually for each activity and regulated by legally and financially binding agreements.
3. The University of Gdańsk hereby informs that the information clause regarding the personal data of individuals representing Namangan State University under this Memorandum, and those appointed by it for contact purposes, in accordance with Articles 13 and 14 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) dated April 27, 2016, is available at the following internet address:

4. The Parties agree that this Memorandum be validly executed using electronic signatures. Each Party consents to use electronic signatures provided such electronic signatures meet internationally recognized standards or the legal requirements applicable in the Parties' respective jurisdictions.

In situations where electronic signatures cannot be used, the Parties agree to the exchange of scanned copies of manually signed documents via email or other secure electronic means.

5. The Agreement will be in effect from the date of signature for a period of five years unless either party gives six months' advance notice in writing to terminate the Agreement.
